

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) about the move of the WMU NC to the Baptist State Convention (BSC):

1.) What if I mailed a letter or contribution to the old address?

We have forwarded all the mail to our new address, but if you see that a check you sent did not clear the bank, you can assume we did not get the letter. Moving this close to Christmas has caused our forwarding mail to be delayed due to the high volumes during the Holiday season.

3.) How is having offices in the Baptist State Convention different than when the WMU offices were there pre-2008?

For many decades pre-2008 we were employed by the BSC and salaries and benefits came from the donations of churches to the BSC. This time we are autonomous and **do not receive any funds from the BSC**. Our staff this time is hired and paid by WMU NC. We will trust the churches and individuals to continue to give to the ministries of WMU NC through the Heck-Jones offering, donations, and memorials to provide for our staff and ministries.

As our bylaws state, WMUNC honors this common heritage as laborers together in Christian work with the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina in the promotion of Christ-centered and Bible-based missions and ministry locally and globally. WMU NC may also cooperate, as it deems advisable, with other entities that share a common purpose in promoting Christ-centered and Bible-based missions and ministries locally and globally.

4.) What are the benefits from the move?

- Since our founding in 1886, WMU NC has partnered with churches throughout North Carolina to provide equipping resources and missions opportunities for leaders and believers. We have continued this partnership and worked together to promote giving to state, national, and international mission's offerings. We desire to reach more churches with our curriculum and encourage engagement with every church, no matter location or size.
