

Top Ten Tips for Using myMISSION Curriculum

Each month, a new issue of myMISSION Leader is available for download for you to lead a young women's group focused on missions through the following plans:

- Faith—a time of Bible study and discussion to apply what you've learned
- Community—an opportunity to bond with your myMISSIONSM group members through a get-together based on truths from the Faith section
- Missions—a missions project based on truths from the Faith section, followed by a missions-learning experience coupled with a meaningful prayer time

Consider the following tips as you plan your group time.

- Review the month's meeting plan options. Start with the Faith section to build a biblical foundation, and then move to the Community and Missions plans. Choose the one that best suits the purpose of your group. Consider alternating plans each time you meet.
- Plan ahead. Secure the needed supplies for the plan of your choice and enlist any needed volunteers. The more you involve, the more interest you'll have from your group.
- Guard against one person talking too much. Provide opportunities for all to contribute to the discussion. Share yourself with the group; dare to be vulnerable.
- Vary the location of your meeting.
- Look for ways to involve other young women in your church, association, or college campus.
- Rotate the leadership.
- Consider adopting a ministry or mission site for a semester or six-month period in order to build lasting relationships.
