

Five Mission Projects

FOR THE NEW YEAR THAT YOU CAN DO FROM HOME.

- Take the Christmas cards you got for Christmas. Pick one per day and pray for the person that sent you that card. It may be for salvation, or they may have health needs or other spiritual needs. Or maybe they just need for hope during the pandemic!
- The elderly have really suffered during the pandemic. Loneliness and isolation are very problematic for an older person (for anyone really). Pick an elderly person in your church, mission group, or a neighbor. Pray for them daily. Send cards to them. Call them. When safe, go and visit them, or drop off goodies on the porch.
- Lottie Moon Christmas offering- did you know that many Baptist churches in NC do not give to the Lottie Moon Christmas offering for International missions? The Executive Board of WMU NC and the staff wrote personal letters to the pastors of some of these churches. The offering is also taken during the months following December. Pray that these pastors will lead their church into supporting our missionaries.
- Many ministries are provided in December to meet the needs of many. We give shoe boxes to children in need or to the children of Appalachia. We give Red Boxes to the incarcerated women in NC. We give toys to Angel Tree children, who have one parent that is incarcerated. We buy other toys for needy children. If you were able to do one of these ministries, pray for the child/person who got your toy, backpack, or box. We do these ministries to reach spiritual needs too- and prayer is the answer to that!
- These are difficult days with the pandemic. Many families were not able to gather together during the holidays. There is a lot of grief and pain that is associated with that. Pray for those that had a difficult Christmas season. Send a card, Give them grace in this difficult time.
