

## Top Ten Tips for Using Adults on Mission Curriculum

**Adults on Mission leader:** Follow these tips for making the most of your Adults on Mission<sup>SM</sup> resources.

1. Pray for God's leadership for your group. He will direct your paths into greater missional involvement.
2. Review the current Missions Plan Book. This resource is organized by quarters (fall, winter, spring, summer). Each quarter includes articles for each of three months. Each month features a Bible study, mission study, prayer page, special emphasis, and meeting plan.
3. Review additional information at [wmu.com/adults](http://wmu.com/adults) and [wmu.com/MPB](http://wmu.com/MPB).
4. Customize the plans to best meet the needs of your group. Use these ideas as springboards for your own plans. Create your own adaptations.
5. Consider what missions project your group could do together. Adults on Mission groups often learn more by doing than by meeting.
6. Enlist others in your group to assist you with the planning. Provide opportunities for all to participate. Make sure everyone is using his or her gifts. Consider rotating leadership within your group.
7. Secure the needed supplies and make any necessary arrangements.
8. Vary the location of your meeting occasionally.
9. Consider adopting a ministry or mission site for a longer period of time in order to build lasting relationships.
10. Make time after your projects to discuss what you have learned. You will often find members of your group discussing topics and ideas from your curriculum. This is an important step as they process all that God is showing them.
